Bonaccorsi Sebastiano Pinot Noir

VITICULTURE:

Apellation: Sta. Rita Hills AVA  
Varietal: 100% Pinot Noir  
Clone: Swan(mostly), Mt. Eden, Pommard  
Vineyard: Sebastiano, steep Southern facing slope  
with bits of clay and shoal, NE edge of AVA

WINEMAKING:

Time in Oak: 22 mos.  
Finning: No fining or filtering  
Alcohol: 13.7%  
Cases produced: 200  
Winemaker: Jenne Bonaccorsi

NOTES:

Dark ruby red, opaque center. Deep and dark, reminiscent of black cherry, plum and earl grey tea. Rich and mouth-filling pinot noir, full of blackcherry and black raspberry, cracked peppercorn and spice. Refreshing cran-rasberry acidity on the back end and finish.

\*from Jenne Bonaccorsi – It is hard to believe that it has been almost 10 years working with this vineyard. A very special vineyard for me, as I was able to plant Swan clone that is not readily available in the Central Coast.
