2018 Estate Dry Farmed Rosé Wine

We have been sustainably dry-farming premium quality grapes for over 25 years. Our vineyard has the notable distinction of being located within 3 of the most desirable grape growing AVA's including the Russian River Valley, Green Valley and Sonoma Coast. All of the grapes grown in our Estate Vineyard are used exclusively in Square Peg Estate wines.

Winemaking

The 2018 Estate Rosé wine is a blend of our Estate Pinot Noir (40%) and Zinfandel (60%) grapes. All clusters are pressed whole and then gently transferred to stainless steel tanks and neutral oak barrels for fermentation. Whole cluster pressing reduces contact time with the stems and skins, creating a delicate Rosé with light peach color and balanced acidity. Alcohol by volume is 12.5%. 300 cases made.

Tasting Notes

Characterized by a distinct strawberry nose followed by an entry exhibiting subtle bursts of peach, pear and melon giving way to a crisp refreshing finishing.
